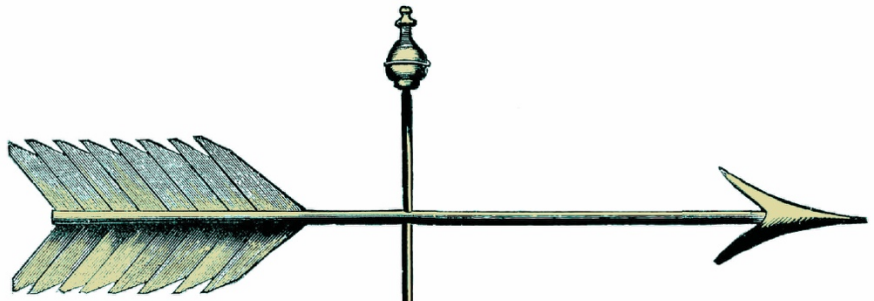


Charleston Airborne Flooded (South Carolina),
